A one-time \$50 Administration Fee will be assessed on new memberships.

When determining the number of employees, two part-time employees equal one full-time employee.

A discount applies when two or more business locations with the same ownership and under the same name become members. The location with the largest number of employees pays dues at the standard rate. Each additional location pays 25% off the standard rate based on the number of employees at that location.

Individual Membership is available for those who do not own or act on behalf of any trade, business, profession, or organization. Individual Member dues are \$50 per year.

Membership dues are not a charitable tax deduction. They are tax deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense.

COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

Business Education Committee: develops programs to promote business in the City including Table Tops, Annual Installation Dinner, Taste & Tour of Little Saigon, training seminars, workshops and more; makes recommendations to the City on ways to improve the business climate; and encourages educational partnerships on all levels.

Membership Committee: the “growth” arm of the Chamber—responsible for adding New Members by various membership events; greeting and mentoring New Members at Luncheons and Mixers; and assisting with Grand Openings and Ribbon Cuttings.

Legislation Committee: promotes the concerns of business on legislative and economic issues and governmental matters; encourages economic development projects in the community; updates members on the laws and issues affecting business; and arranges the Chamber’s Annual State of the City Luncheon, Candidates Forum, and other various related activities. *Monthly meetings* offer the opportunity for members to meet and talk with representatives from City, County, State, and Federal offices. *The Committee evaluates* and actively supports, opposes or takes no position on Federal, State and County *legislation and issues impacting business*. Regarding State and Local propositions and issues, the Committee evaluates and recommends positions for a vote by the Board of Directors.

Community Committee: provides service and support to the Community, especially in the areas of social service and cultural activities and arranges the Public Service Awards luncheon, Salute to Senior Luncheon and more.
